Basic Policy on Product Safety

1. Compliance with Laws and Regulations
We comply with all laws, regulations, guidelines, and other standards related to product safety.

We provide our employees with education and training on the aforementioned laws, regulations, and other standards, as well as our internal rules and regulations, working to ensure that this knowledge is thoroughly instilled in all employees.

2. Ensuring Product Safety
We do our utmost to provide safe products that our customers can use with confidence. To this end, we continuously strive to improve safety by adhering to voluntary safety standards in addition to safety standards set forth in laws and industry guidelines. We provide education and training to our employees and other related personnel to ensure product safety and prevent product accidents.

3. Responding to Product Accidents
We have established a system that enables us to promptly collect information on accidents involving our products.

In the event of a serious accident involving one of our products, we promptly report it to the relevant authorities and work closely with Canon Inc. to provide appropriate information to our customers and others in accordance with appropriate laws and regulations. We take measures such as recalling or repairing products when deemed necessary in response to product accidents.

4. Formulating and Implementing Voluntary Action Plans
In keeping with this basic policy, we formulate and implement voluntary action plans for product safety and work to continuously improve them to ensure their effectiveness, thereby fostering and establishing a corporate culture that emphasizes customer focus and product safety assurance.
